## KENDRIYA ARYA YUVAK PARISHAD (K.A.Y.P.)

### ACTIVITIES & ACHIEVEMENTS

1. K.A.Y.P. organizes annual Character Formation and Personality Development Camps for Young boys and girls in different cities of India in summers, through its various successfully running branches. The aim of these camps is to introduce young generation with the core Indian and Vaidic Values; Morals and Principles through conferences and lectures by esteemed Arya saints; along with physical training which involves training of Lathi, Sword training, Pranayam, Yoga, Karate, Judo, Lazium, Marching, Dumbles, etc. This year too 18 camps were organized in different cities and almost 2000 young children were trained through these camps.
2. K.A.Y.P. organizes 3 days Annual Arya Mahasammelan in the month of January every year. The program commences with a Shobhayatra. Bahu (Multi) kund yagya is organized daily as a ceremonial start of the day by various Arya samajis. The sammelan is divided into various sessions such as: Yoga session, Performance display by the trained youths; Conference and discussion on the emergent topics; Arya Mahila (women) Sammelan; Kavi (poetry) Sammelan; Bhajan Singing; and the Rishi Langar (Prasad) being distributed for 3 whole days.
3. K.A.Y.P. also organizes annual Yuva Sanskar Abhiyan on the occasion of "Shrawani Parv" in the month of August. Every year 10,000 young boys and girls are given Janehu "Upanayana" (ceremonial threads) to be worn in order to enable them to imbibe Indian culture and tradition; along with its relevance is told to them.
4. K.A.Y.P. actively organizes various protests, seminars, talks, demonstrations, rally, sit-in, peace camps and the like at Jantar Mantar, New Delhi to create awareness among the people as well as to draw attention of the government officials and authorities on emergent National issues and social evils; be it paying tribute to Nirbhaya or protest against terrorism, drugs addiction etc.
- 5) K.A.Y.P. has a women wing titled '**Kendriya Arya Yuvati Parishad**' which organizes youth camps for young girls every year. Symposiums, seminars and conferences on Women related issues and concerns and further development of Arya Samaj are also its core concern.
6. K.A.Y.P. publishes its Bi-monthly Newspaper titled "Yuva Udgoshh" edited by the founder President (Mr. Anil Arya) himself. The paper has been creating awareness among masses since 32 years and is widely circulated.

7. The young boys and girls so trained at K.A.Y.P. camps; further participate, voluntarily cooperate and humbly serve in various Arya samaj's programmes with zest and zeal. Such are the values, morals and motivational spirits imbibed by them.
8. Following the teachings of Arya Samaj, K.A.Y.P. discards and repudiates the social evils of drug abuse, alcoholism, consumption of non-veg, smoking etc; and same is propagated through its actions and deeds.
9. K.A.Y.P. organizes National Arya Youth Conference in the 1st week of September every year wherein emergent social and National issues and core concerns of Arya Samaj are discussed by the intellectuals.
10. K.A.Y.P. promotes social development and social work by distributing free books, uniforms, financial assistance, food and stationary to poor students and the underprivileged section.
11. K.A.Y.P. organizes symposiums on National and social issues; Yagya-Hawan, Vedic teaching in the rural and backward areas of various cities to spread the spirit of Arya Samaj.
12. K.A.Y.P. aims to develop talent and personality of the young players, sports men and women by organizing various sports competitions and games; and thereby awards them to motivate them in this field.
